EPoS and MaCCI invite applications for a Summer School on Platform Economics by Ph.D. students and recent post-docs (up to three years after graduating, counted from the application deadline), to be held at Jugendstilhotel Trifels in Annweiler from Monday July 18 to Friday, July 22, 2022.

During this summer school Julian Wright (National University of Singapore) and Martin Peitz (University of Mannheim) present recent theoretical advances in the economics of platforms. Each day there will be one morning lecture complemented by two student presentations with ensuing discussion. Tutoring sessions are offered in the afternoon.

Students at the summer school can apply to present their unpublished work on platforms – this work can be a completed working paper or an incomplete draft, theoretical and empirical work will be considered. This material should be included in the application package (see below).

LOCATION Kurhaus Trifels in Annweiler, a nice wine-growing area between Heidelberg

and Strasbourg, about two hours by train from Frankfurt airport.

DATES Arrival on Sunday, July, 17; Departure on Friday, July 22 after 3pm

PARTICIPANTS 20 participants and a few researchers from EPoS as additional attendants

PARTICIPATION FEE 300 EUR for admitted students to be paid within two weeks of notification

TRAVEL EXPENSES, Lodging and meals during the summer school will be covered; travel LODGING & BOARD expenses (economy class airfare and second class train fare) will be

reimbursed according to our guidelines that will be made available upon

acceptance (attending the whole Summer School is required).

CHILDCARE Limited childcare facilities will be available for participants with young

children.
